

APPLICATION FORM

1. Application Process

Any Manitoba-based trucking firm/owner-operator interested in participating in the Manitoba GrEEEn Trucking Program MUST COMPLETE and SUBMIT the following:

- Application Form
- Valid Manitoba Driver's License (owner-operators only)
- Valid Vehicle Registration (all candidate units)
- Proof of Vehicle Ownership (owner-operators only)

Please mail or fax all documents, including completed Application Form to the *University of Manitoba Transport Institute ("UMTI")*. Contact information is indicated below.

2. Request for Payment Process

Successful applicants will be required to select and purchase the technologies most suitable for their equipment. Following the purchase and installation of selected technologies, applicants MUST SUBMIT a completed **REQUEST FOR PAYMENT FORM** (available online) along with copies of the following documentation to UMTI:

- Invoices/Receipts for the equipment purchased
- Certification of equipment installation

As part of the Request for Payment process, applicants will need to provide baseline information on fuel consumption, distance travelled and other items for each tractor/trailer unit for the year prior to program entry (form available online). This and other subsequent data reporting requirements will be submitted to the *Centre for Sustainable Transportation (CST)* to the address listed below.

3. Key Dates/Other Criteria

The GrEEEn Trucking Program is a limited funding initiative. Applications are accepted on a first come, first served basis. UMTI will notify applicants via e-mail, within 30 days after the submission of applications whether they have been selected for the Program. Maximum number of eligible tractors/trailers or combination is 20 units per company for year 2009. Eligible technologies that were purchased between July 16 and September 15 but not applied for during the initial application period (ending July 15) will be considered during this application period. Applications will be accepted until **December 15, 2009**. Request for Payment information is to be submitted no later than **January 30, 2010**.

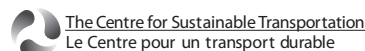
