Commercial Vehicle Operators' Registration (CVOR) Written Test

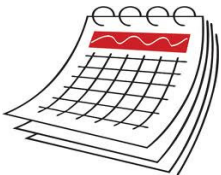


Effective October 1, 2013

To improve road safety and promote a better understanding of CVOR requirements, the Ministry of Transportation (MTO) requires new Ontario-based operators to complete a CVOR written test prior to operating on Ontario roads.



The CVOR test is to be completed after MTO has reviewed and accepted a CVOR application from an Ontario-based operator.



The test must be **successfully** completed within six months of MTO accepting the CVOR application. To prepare for the test, applicants should review the Commercial Vehicle Operators' Safety (CVOS) manual at www.mto.gov.on.ca/english/trucks.

Where?

To be completed in person at a DriveTest Centre in Ontario. DriveTest Centre locations can be found at www.drivetest.ca.



The test is to be completed by: an owner, sole proprietor, partner, corporate officer or director of a corporation.

Just the Facts

- The CVOR test is a one-time requirement.
- A CVOR application must be submitted prior to writing the CVOR test.
- The test must be completed in order to obtain the CVOR certificate.
- The test consists of 30 multiple-choice questions.
- Cost is \$32 for each test or retest.



The test must be successfully completed and a CVOR certificate issued before operating on Ontario roads.
